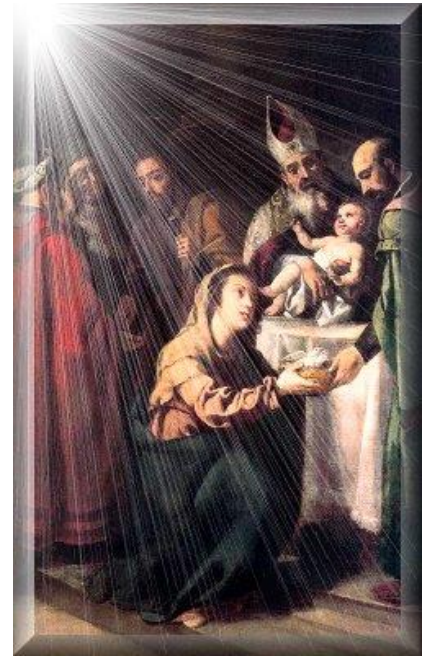

The time between Christmastide and the beginning of Lent is considered the Time of

Septuagesima which is a time to prepare for Lent that encompasses the last three weeks of this month with Lent set to begin March 1. It is an opportunity to offer our Rosaries and daily sacrifices, crosses and submission to God's holy Will to regiment ourselves for penance and self-sacrifice and recommit to Fight 4 the True Faith against all who would oppose or compromise it.
